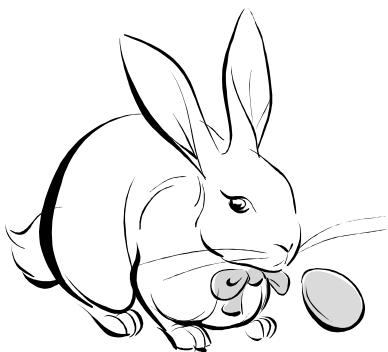
Open House—April 23rd
